The Alameda Commuters Golf Committee is proud to announce the playing of the 92<sup>nd</sup> annual Alameda Commuters Golf Tournament. Each year the "Commuters" tournament continues to stand out as one of the premier amateur golfing events in Northern California.

Amazingly, 91 years ago, the Commuters golf tournament started as a fun affair for the boys riding the 7:30 ferry to San Francisco every morning. Very quickly it became an annual event that everybody wanted to enter. The first Alameda Commuters tournament was held in July of 1928 - the first prize was a keg of nails awarded to J. Charles Jordon and the last place was a sack of manure. Today the NCGA has maintained the point level at 200 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, one of the highest point levels in Northern California amateur golf.

This year a select field of over 200 of the best amateur golfers will compete in the Championship rounds on April 6-7 and April 13-14. During the second weekend of competition, we will hold our 32<sup>nd</sup> annual Alameda Commuters Senior Golf Tournament, a 36-hole event featuring Northern California's outstanding senior amateur players. In addition, the Alameda Commuters will conduct the 2<sup>nd</sup> Alameda Commuters Super Senior division for players 65 years and older, competing on April 9-10.
